Since 1997 the St. Lawrence River Institute of Environmental Sciences has provided local youth with the opportunity to explore nature at Cooper Marsh through the Eco-Friends Summer Day Camp. The camp challenges participants to learn about science and the natural environment in a hands on, minds-on manner. Seven exciting one-week sessions are available for children aged 6-11. Sessions include a combination of hiking, frog catching, pond dipping, games, crafts, scientific experiments and much much more.
